Blue Ridge Baptist Association will celebrate Maryland/Delaware Disaster Recovery Unit 1's twenty years of continuous faithful service at the regular worship service at Faith Baptist on Sunday, April 24, 2022.

Faith Baptist spearheaded Blue Ridge Baptist Associations involvement in Southern Baptist Disaster Relief in May of 2000. Two years later, Recovery 1's original trailer was commissioned at South End Baptist and placed in service on April 27, 2002. 28 hours later a F5 Tornado struck LaPlata Maryland and the following Weekend Recovery 1 was on its first mission. Since then Recovery 1 has deployed twenty times to hurricanes, tornados, floods and other disasters including to Lousianna for Hurricane Katrina.

On Sunday, April 24 we are asking for anyone who has deployed with or has helped with Recovery 1 to join us for this celebration - wearing your yellow shirts of course. We're looking two team members who would like to give a short testimony to speak as well. 
