

IMPORTANT:

A notice has been mailed and emailed about details for how to register church representatives who will be voting for the revised BRBA Constitution and ByLaws. Each church has received a copy of this proposed draft and should review in preparation for voting.

Representatives will need to register on the BRBA website or can email sarah@blueridgebaptist.org with their full name and the church they are representing. They must be members of your church!! We would like to have everyone registered no later than October 6th but we will accept registrations on the day of as well beginning at 6:30pm.

Each member church may designate 5 representatives in addition to the Pastor, for those churches who have less than 100 members. For every 100 members thereafter, you may add 2 additional representatives, not to exceed a maximum of 20 representatives.

OPERATION CHRISTMAS CHILD!

Operation Christmas Child is a project of Samaritan's Purse, an international relief organization. Our mission is to provide local partners around the world with shoeboxes filled with small toys, hygiene items, and school supplies as a means of reaching out to children in their own communities with the Good News of Jesus Christ



We ship these simple gifts outside the United States to children affected by war, poverty, natural disaster, famine, and disease; and to children living on Native American reservations in the U.S. In each shoebox receiving country, we partner with a National Leadership Team that consists of year-round volunteers from various church denominations. Together, they strategize how to reach children in their country with the Gospel. Because of this strategy, the economic impact on a community is minimal and allows us to reach millions of new children every year with the Good News of Jesus Christ. We disciple thousands of these boys and girls each year, with millions now sharing their faith with their friends, family, and beyond.

Drop off locations will be listed on their website the first week of October. National Collection Week is November 14-21, 2022

You can also mail your box to their offices listed on their website. Lastly, you can build a shoebox on their website, choosing the items you wish to include for \$25. This requires no work on your side but going online, choosing the items they offer, and purchasing the box for \$25! How amazing is technology! Location: IHOP: 134 Jefferson Crossing Way Charlestown WV



Annual BRBA Meeting Anticipation

This year's annual meeting promises to be filled with all kinds of encouraging information and experiences. We'll be hearing from one of our pastors, Phil Graves from FBC Brunswick, about how he and his wife went to war torn Ukraine to rescue their newly adopted daughter. He'll share how risky it was to enter a war zone and how God protected them all along the way.

We'll also hear from Pastor Chad Hooker who serves at Calvary Baptist in War, WV. You will get to hear about mission work that has already happened there and will be given a list of needs there that BRBA churches can play a part in or assist Calvary Baptist with. You will get to meet Chad and his family and begin to think of ways that your church can assist and encourage them.

Also this year, we will be looking to update our old 2005 Constitution and Bylaws that have been worked on by a revision committee for almost 2 years. So much has changed in the last 17 years, including me being hired as DOM 14 years ago. When I started serving BRBA, it became obvious to me that we needed to try some new methods to ensure the vibrant health of our association in the future. Strategic planning and experimentation became necessary especially after the North American Mission Board cut financial support to all associations in 2010. This new Constitution will now align us with many of those changes that we have tried for a dozen years and will bring our governing documents more in line with the way we have already been operating.

Our Constitution & Bylaws revision committee has been through 2 chairmen and a host of other minor delays. We have received input from numerous sources on modern trends in Associational missions work. One important challenge that the committee adhered to was to simplify and shorten our governing documents to what was legally necessary and applicable to our needs and to consider having a separate set of operational procedures. Professionals in the field and legal advisors, recommended that we condense these governing rules and make sure that we meet the legal requirements of the State of Maryland, but not to overload these documents with too many extraneous operational items. Having a separate policy manual would allow BRBA to then grow without the need for a major Constitutional change with each minor alteration. Our committee has come up with a document that should serve us well, following the wise advice that was received.

Because a new Constitution is a major item of business, we are asking every BRBA church to send official credentialed messengers to the annual meeting this year to vote in the business session, as mentioned in the front page of the newsletter and a letter sent out individually by email and physical mail this week. Registration can be done on our BRBA website. The other option is to contact Sarah in the BRBA office (240) 818-8760, or sarah@blueridgebaptist.org to register who will be your messengers this year (full name and the church they are representing). They must be members of your church! This is a very important year for each church to have representation at the Fall meeting of BRBA.
