FROM YOUR DIRECTOR OF MISSIONS:



Recently the Blue Ridge Baptist Association discovered that some checks sent from BRBA churches to support local missions were intercepted by a thief, and were fraudulently cashed or diverted to an outside account. I am personally doing an investigation, and asking ALL of our church treasurers and bookkeepers to check in with me providing records of your giving to BRBA during 2024. If your church treasurer has not contacted me yet - please ask them to call me ASAP so we can get the needed information to complete our investigation. Maryland State Police as well as U.S. Postal Service investigators are also involved in this case, because interception of mail is a Federal crime.

We ask that you pray for whomever is responsible for this theft, and for all who are looking into the details of these events - asking God for justice to be done, and for future thefts to be thwarted by the work we are doing now.

New safeguards are already in place, and we will report more on our findings as they become available. To date we have tracked down over \$3,300. that was intercepted and stolen in the calendar year 2024.

PAYING IT FORWARD mission plant helps mission plant

When Hagerstown Church started as a mission church plant - they were a "portable church" that literally backed up a trailer at the elementary school where they rented space on Sunday mornings, and unloaded everything they needed to have "church".

A few years back, that mission church merged with 1st Baptist Church of Hagerstown, MD and that union was a gift from God for both churches as they united into one body. That move left the church with a trailer then that went largely unused.

In January the leaders at Hagerstown Church decided to bless <u>Emmaus Church</u> (a new church plant in Baltimore) with their church planting trailer from 2019. Pastor Josh McClain said: We're thankful for these brothers and sisters (and dear friends),

as they plant in Baltimore, and we want to help them in any way we can!" Emmaus Church had their first gathering on February 9th.

HISTORIC BELL REMOVED FROM FIRST BAPTIST of BRUNSWICK



The bell was removed from the historic bell tower today at the First Baptist Church of Brunswick, MD. The property is being sold to a developer, but the bell will remain in memory of all who worshiped and built the church for over 100 years. The church is re-branding as The Crossings Church, and they are now worshipping at the American Legion in Brunswick until they can find land and build a new church building.

BRBA and the BCM/D celebrated annual meetings in October and November 2024, with record numbers attending each event. The BCM/D is selling the Baptist Center in Columbia, MD to gather more resources for missions and ministry among our churches. Congratulations to BRBA for celebrating **70 YEARS** of local missions and ministry in our region.

DOM Bruce Conley also announced the creation of our new **LEGACY FUND** that will honor so many of our devout local pastors and shepherds who have gone on to their heavenly reward. Funds donated to the BRBA legacy fund will be used to help young pastors and church planters with seminary education, and other church revitalization needs. DAVE'S CORNER





Hello I am Dave Hays, and I am here to assist your church with various loaner vehicles and equipment that are available to you as a participating church in the Blue Ridge association.

I wanted to let you know about the latest addition to the BRBA fleet. We have a shuttle bus that we hope will allow us to better serve our churches. It has a wheelchair lift and can seat a total of 17 people. This does bring additional requirements for who can drive it however. Your driver must have a CDL license with a passenger endorsement to drive the shuttle. Because of insurance regulations, there can be no exceptions to this rule. We're working on getting together a list of potential volunteers from our churches who do have a CDL who might be willing to help if your church has no one to serve as driver. Even if the driver has no passengers, he/she must possess a valid CDL.

Another change that we are implementing in 2025 is a suggested donation for using

our venicies. Iviaintenance costs and replacing an old snuttle really nit our budget hard in 2024. We are suggesting that when your church uses a BRBA vehicle - you contribute \$50 for using a trailer (block party / concession) and \$100 for using our buses. These funds will assist us with maintenance, cleaning, MVA fees, and the purchase of parts and new equipment as needed.

If your church can not afford the suggested donation please still reserve and use our vehicles. We will never refuse a church because it cannot cover the recommended donation. These fees are only a suggestion and are not required.
