

A few years back, the Blue Ridge Baptist Association partnered with a small evangelical church on the campus of a mobile home vacation community in Falling Waters, WV. Some were concerned that they weren't necessarily Southern Baptist (since it is a melting pot of vacationers - people from many faiths and backgrounds attend) but the church needed help - so we stepped in. At that time their pastor had passed away, and some elders were stepping in the gap. We sent many of our pulpit supply pastors to preach and our DOM met regularly with their elders.

This year - the church called a new pastor. Derek Marshall (shown right of the baptism candidate in the photo) has kicked the church into overdrive in reaching out to the community! They have done more than a dozen community events - concerts, cookouts, breakfasts - all in which the gospel is presented ... and the results have been amazing! Attendance in this tiny church has increased over 100% this year, with about 80 people attending weekly. They have baptized 15 people to date and hope for more before the park closes at the end of October. Since the chapel cannot be used after the park closes ... they are trying to find space for the church to continue to meet from November

through April when the park reopens.

We rejoice with RIVERBEND CHRISTIAN FELLOWSHIP and Pastor Derek Marshall on the mighty movement of God in that small community of vacationers. We pray that the actions of God's Holy Spirit will continue to spread in that park, and beyond - for many years to come!!

DISASTER RELIEF FOCUS IN BRBA CHURCHES OCTOBER 2025



BRBA is asking all of our churches to pick a Sunday in October, and do an emphasis

on our Disaster Relief Ministry in the Association.



Earlier this year we had volunteers on the ground in Allegeny County - Western Maryland following the floods that devastated that region. They served that community for weeks doing vital clean up / fix up for towns that were devastated by disaster.



Thus far in 2025, Disaster Relief volunteers nationwide have served over 185,000 meals to disaster relief victims, made over 30,000 contacts, made 14,000 gospel presentations, and seen almost 1300 people profess Christ as Savior.

The **BLUE RIDGE BAPTIST ASSOCIATION'S DISASTER RELIEF MINISTRY** is primarily a locally funded ministry in Cooperation with the Baptist Convention of Maryland/ Delaware. While the association budgets to support this group of servants – we rely on a yearly special "love offering" from our churches to buy needed equipment and replace aging service tools. REMEMBERING CHARLIE KIRK

Many Americans are in a state of shock and deep sorrow at the news of Charlie Kirk's death. Personally, I was struck by his courage, clarity, and conviction. I admired him greatly—not just for his public influence, but for the integrity and faith he lived out in his life.



Tragically, Charlie did not get to live a long life—he was just 31 years old, but he did live an impactful one. As Corrie ten Boom said, "The measure of a life, after all, is not its duration, but its donation." Charlie certainly made a great donation with his life.

He began Turning Point USA at the age of 18 and made a difference on so many college campuses. He talked with students, gave speeches, and powerfully communicated through logic, clarity, courage, and peace. He was a patriot and American who loved his country. He was an evangelist of sorts to many young people in our land.

But first and foremost, Charlie Kirk was a Christian, devoted husband, and loving father. He was a bold voice for Jesus Christ. His faith is what motivated him in life and why I believe he accomplished so much in a relatively short life. Perhaps the greatest tribute we can pay to Charlie – is to share Christ with others around us, and

speaking unashamedly on cultural issues – especially those that attack our Christian faith.

Charlie is now in Heaven. The moment he took his last breath here on earth, he was in the presence of our Lord. He is in total peace, total bliss. He is now safe in the arms of Jesus.

Missionary Jim Elliot - who was martyred for his faith, wrote in his journal, "I seek not a long life, but a full one, like you, Lord Jesus."

Charlie made a huge difference with it. His legacy will continue on. We thank God for him and we thank God for the influence he's had. Others will carry on with Charlie's legacy – because ultimately it wasn't Charlie's mission, but God's.



Pray for Charlie's wife, Erika, and their two young children who won't understand why

their dad isn't coming home. May the God of all comfort surround them with peace and strength in the days and years ahead.


