My parents taught me to be frugal. My kids used to say that I was cheap. When they were growing up, I used to hate the fact that Christmas wrapping paper was so expensive, and after going through all the trouble of wrapping gifts and putting on pretty ribbons and bows ... they would only tear the wrapping to shreds on Christmas morning like a tornado through a Kansas farmhouse, leaving all of that investment good for nothing but the trash can or the fireplace. As a frugal Father, how did I handle that? Well, starting in September each year - I would save the Sunday comics section from our Sunday newspaper (the Washington Post) and then come December, I would wrap some of their gifts in comics instead of sanctioned Christmas wrapping paper! WHY NOT? It was colorful, and everyone likes to see Snoopy and Charlie Brown at Christmas, right? As it turns out ... it really didn't matter to them WHAT the gifts were wrapped in on Christmas morning, as long as they got the presents they had been wanting so badly.

When Christmas rolls around each year, we can stress out about many things. Getting the right gift to make your loved one happy, or making sure you have the correct or most beautiful paper to wrap it in can seem to be important. I want to challenge you this year however to focus on something else. About 2,000 years ago God sent His only son into the world as His gift to us. John 1 says that the Word became flesh and dwelt among us. At His birth, angels appeared in the fields near Bethlehem to announce to shepherds that the Messiah had come. The instruction was to "go find Him". Luke 2:12 says, "And you will recognize him by this sign: You will find a baby wrapped snugly in strips of cloth, lying in a manger". God's greatest gift was wrapped in swaddling clothes and lying in a feeding trough rather than in kingly garments in a palace. His gift was to ALL people who would receive Him.

Jesus was God's gift to us. What we do with that gift - is our gift to God. So many people like to leave Him as a baby lying in a manager, but His birth never saves them. That birth in Bethlehem was given so that God could be WITH us and *identify* with us. Christ knows our pains, our struggles - even our temptations. His eventual death on the cross was a *massive* gift which opened a way for us to be with God. He was born to die so that we may <u>truly</u> live, not only in this life - but for eternity. In response, our gift back to God should be a life wrapped in His grace, filled with His love and sharing His message to a world in need.

When we unwrap the story of His life and what He did for us, we should desire to live a life that reflects that kind of grace, love, and mercy. Listen - the wrapping doesn't have to be pretty and perfect because God doesn't look on the outside like we do. He sees our hearts.


